- We are happy to welcome back families with children but <u>it is required to wear face coverings</u> <u>inside our facility for all volunteers</u>

You should not volunteer if you:

- Are currently diagnosed with COVID
- Have been exposed to someone with COVID
- Have a fever, cough or shortness of breath
- Are not feeling well for any reason
